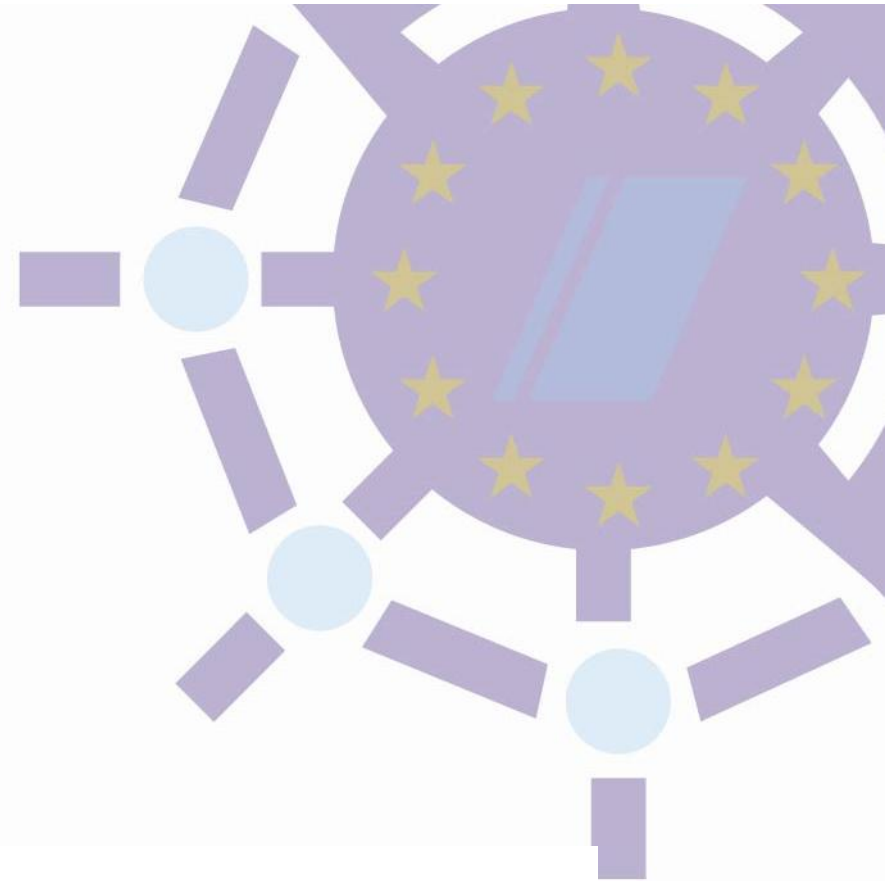

Objectives



- ECGFA NET II is direct continuation for the ECGFA NET designed to ensure that the results of the first phase are sustainable
- General Objective: to enhance educational cooperation in the field of coast guard functions (CGF) and, consequently, to facilitate the interoperability and cooperation amongst different bodies carrying out coast guard functions in order to enhance the coherence and effectiveness of CGF activities.
- *Specific objective 1:* to provide support for the ECGF Training Network and the ECGF Training Portal during their start-up phase in order to increase the number of members and to enable the Network to function in an active and autonomous manner, taking ownership on the Network, its activities and future development.
- *Specific objective 2:* to launch a pilot ECGF Expert Exchange Programme in order to increase the sharing of knowledge and skills in the CGF sector and to assess the future needs of the Exchange Programme.
- *Specific objective 3:* to advance the development of the CGFSQF by drafting the final structure of the CGFSQF (stages 2-3 out of 7)

ECGF Exchange Pilot assessment



- 11 organizations participated in the Pilot Exchange either as hosts by sending participants to the Exchange
- 16 Exchangees, 9 participants on courses, 7 on the job trainings
- The implementation period should have been longer

- The training portal did not support the implementation of the Exchange due to technical problems

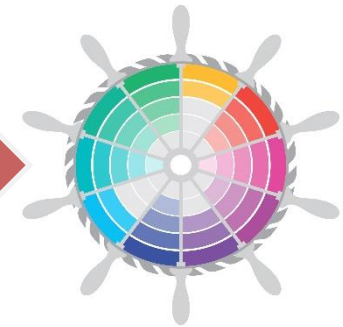

- The main reason for a continuation project is the finalisation of the development of the Coast Guard Functions Sectoral Qualifications Framework (CGFSQF)
 - Stages 4-7: assessment, adoption and dissemination of the CGFSQF at national and international levels
- Other objectives are to support to the ECGF Training Network and continue the ECGF Training Exchange
- Implementation beginning in 2018 (duration 15 months)

- Due to the requirements of the Commission, in order to receive funding the ECGF Exchange Program must include participants from non-EU countries

1. Background

The need for a continuation project for the current ECGFA NET II stems mainly from the finalization of the SQF for CGF. Discussions with DG MARE have been ongoing during the project, and the focus has been on what the Commission sees as relevant contents for the follow-up project. As the final work program for EMFF is still in the process of being finalized, there has been no certainty of the demands of the commission until recently.

The FBG and ITCG have prepared a concept paper for DG MARE, in which the ECGFA NET III project was outlined. In addition to the SQF work, the continuation of the ECGF Exchange programme was proposed either by growing the number of participants, or by creating a common CGF course. The

1. A "common CGF" course with trainers as the focus group. The number of participants would be reasonably small (max 15) and the course would consist of 3-4 modules with a duration of one week each. The participants of each module would not necessarily need to be the same.
2. A similar course for the project participants' training staff and in addition, a separate practical exchange for non-EU and operational personnel.
3. Continue the ECGF Exchange along the lines of the Pilot exchange. The only difference would be the participation of non-EU nationals.
